

SIMPLE PAST	POSITIVE FORM	NEGATIVE FORM	QUESTION FORM	SHORT ANSWERS
Verb TO BE I / He / She / It was bored. We / You / They were bored. SOGG + WAS/WERE	I / He / She / It wasn't bored We / You / They weren't bored. SOGG + WASN'T/WEREN'T	Was I /he/she/it bored? Were we/you/they bored? → Why were you bored? (QUESTION WORD, se c'è +) WAS/WERE + SOGG	Yes, I was. // Yes, we were. No, I wasn't // No, you weren't.	
REGULAR VERBS Base form + ED (attenzione alle eccezioni) You played football yesterday. → stessa forma per tutte le persone SOGG + VERBO FORMA BASE CON L'AGGIUNTA DI ED	You didn't play football yesterday. → stessa forma per tutte le persone SOGG + DIDN'T + VERBO FORMA BASE	Did you play football yesterday? When did you play football? (QUESTION WORD, se c'è +) DID + SOGG + VERBO ALLA FORMA BASE	Yes, I did. // No, I didn't.	
IRREGULAR VERBS She went to Australia last year. Go / <u>went</u> / gone: si usa la seconda voce del paradigma, che corrisponde al Simple Past. → stessa forma per tutte le persone SOGG + VERBO FORMA BASE CON L'AGGIUNTA DI ED	She didn't go to Australia last year. → attenzione: didn't+forma base (prima voce del paradigma) → stessa forma per tutte le persone SOGG + DIDN'T + VERBO FORMA BASE	Did she go to Australia last year? (QUESTION WORD, se c'è +) DID + SOGG + VERBO ALLA FORMA BASE	Yes, she did // No, she didn't.
